- **National Leadership Unit Award**

- **Department Leadership Award**
Patty Cooper PDP Unit Leadership Award
Awarded to the unit submitting the best overall narrative report of their year-round activities promoting leadership within their unit.

- **Unit Member of the Year Award**

The Unit Member of the Year Award recognizes those serving at the unit level who exemplify the values and ideals of the Auxiliary and whose accomplishments significantly impact the program work in their units.

Any senior member in good standing who has not held an office higher than unit president qualifies for this award. Selection is based on accomplishments, activities, etc. Only one entry per unit, a narrative with no more than 1,000 words, including the name of the nominee, in a secret envelope. Must include unit president's signature unless the nominee is the unit president in such cases, a past president can sign.

- **Gen Horne Past Presidents Parley Award**

Awarded to the unit submitting the best report of unit Past President Parley activities including work on membership.

- **National Salute to Servicewomen Award**

All branches of the service including National Guard and Reserve. Form and requirements are on the national website alaforveterans.org
