- 4. Write a bulletin for distribution to Units with Leadership "how to" information.
- 5. Contact District Presidents and offer your services for District sponsored Leadership training.
- 6. Promote the National American Legion Auxiliary's ALA Academy found on the National American Legion Auxiliary website.
