Since 1948, when President Harry Truman established the AFR, it has been helping the Air Force accomplish its objectives. Initially, it was only a reserve force, but now it makes up 20% of the active-duty work of the United States Air Force.

Army Reserve Birthday

On April 23, 1908, Congress organized a group of 160 doctors to form the Medical Reserve Corps. The aim was to provide the nation with a team of medical professionals who have been professionally trained to be used during national emergencies. The bill was signed by President Theodore Roosevelt, who was one of the greatest citizen-soldiers of the Army Reserve, a month later. In 1920, Congress established the Organized Reserves for Officers through the National Defense Act. That reserve force today is known as the U.S. Army Reserve.
