You will fill in the required information. It asks for you to attach a narrative report either in PDF or Word form. So have your report uploaded on your computer before you start. You also can attach photos in JPG, JPEG format not larger than 14mb or a PDF document. So, you will want those available.

Once you have completed the entry and submitted it you will receive a confirmation notice.
